Rankings, Entry Fees and Tables explained

- Players who have not previously competed at a ranking tournament are assigned the rank of beginner. Players who have previously competed will have a rank assigned of Novice, Amateur, Semi-Pro, Pro or Pro-Master, depending on the number of ranking points they have accumulated.
- Entry fees are stated above either per person or per team. In the case of per team, the team assumes the rank of the highest ranked player in that team and pays an entrance fee according to that rank. * Entry fees above are quoted in the order: Beginner / Novice / Amateur / Semi-Pro / Pro / Pro-Master
- Overseas players will be treated as having their highest published rank in the UK or European points lists. All unranked overseas players will be assigned a minimum rank of Pro unless previously agreed.
- All events will be held on World-Championship spec Garlando tables unless specified

The organisers reserve the right to alter the programme to ensure the smooth running of the event.

The prize fund may vary according to turnout

The promoter reserves the right to refuse entry
